

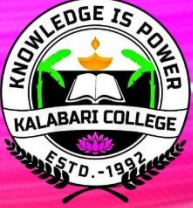

ELIGIBILITY THE UG PROGRAMMES:

Senior Secondary School Leaving Certificate or Higher Secondary (12th Grade) Certificate obtained after successful completion of Grade 12 or stage of education corresponding to Level-4. Admission to the UP Programmes will purely be in merit basis subject to the reservation policy of Assam Govt. and will be based on allotment of subjects leading to Major at the first semester with an option to change Major subject in 3rd after completion of first year subject to availability of seats in the concerned department.

ABOUT THE UG PROGRAMMES:

Undergraduate degree programmes of either 3 or 4-year duration. With multiple entry and exit and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications such as:

- ❖ a UG certificate after completing 1 year (2 semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study.
- ❖ a UG diploma after 2 years (4 semesters) of study.
- ❖ a bachelor's degree after a 3-year (6 semesters) programme of study.
- ❖ a 4-year bachelor's degree (honours) after eight semesters programme of study. If the student completes a rigorous research project in their major area(s) of study in the 4th year of a bachelor's degree (Honours with research).

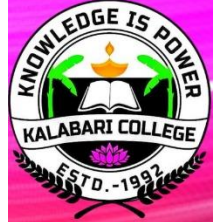

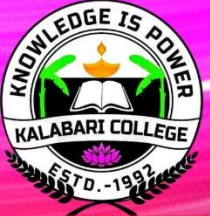

COLLEGE LIBRARY AND LIBRARY RULES:

There is a well-managed library. The library is equipped with substantial number of books and journals to satisfy curriculum, researches and other references.

A student can take the various services of the library such as book reading, newspaper reading, journal and magazine reading, borrowing books on loan for reading in their home, etc. by applying on a separate application provided by the librarian within a specified period of time. After taking admission in the college each student are requested to contact the librarian to apply for the Library Card.

The library remains open from 10.00 a.m. to 4 p.m. on each working day except the gazette holidays, Sundays and any other declared holidays. To digitize its library service Soul 2.0 is install in the library in November, 2019. A new Library building is under construction for the library within the college premises and is about to complete.

LIBRARY RULES

1. To obtain, various services of the library a Library card is must. So after taking admission in the college each student are requested to apply for the library I-card by taking an application form the library office.
2. Library card is not transferable. In each student name there is only one Library card.
3. Books are issued to the students for a period of fifteen (15) days only for the first time, after that the same book can be renewed for two (2) times i.e. 30 days. After that the specified book has to return and can take another book on loan.
4. An overdue charge of Rs1/- only per day is levied if a book is kept beyond due time.
5. Borrowers must check the physical condition of the Book before getting them issued. Otherwise they will be held responsible for any damage or mutation notice at the time of return.
6. Books on loan with members can be recalled at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
7. A fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged for reissue of a Library card.
8. Each member of the library is responsible for any misuse of the library card issued in their name. So if a library card is lost due to some reason it is the duty of a member to inform the librarian immediately with an application form, otherwise he/she will be responsible for any misuse of the card.

STUDENTS AID FUND:

On application to the Principal an amount upto a minimum of Rs. 300/(Three hundred) and above only is granted to the poor and meritorious students whose fathers/guardians' annual income does not exceed Rs. 50,000.00 to enable him purchase etc.

GENERAL ROLLS FOR MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE IN THE COLLEGE

1. All notices desired to be pasted or circulated by the students anywhere in the college shall require the approval of the principal.
2. Principal's signature over the identity Card of the students shall be affixed within 15 days from the date of admission.
3. Filled up registration form should be submitted in the office within the stipulated time as fixed by college office. No. registration form will be received after such time.
4. The following activates of the students in the college will be treated as a serious offence. All powers for maintaining discipline are vested with the principal and the disciplinary action committee and their decision shall be final in all such matters.

 - ii) Forcible disruption of classes.
 - iii) Destruction of college properties like furniture's, walls, fencing etc.
 - iv) Misbehaviour shown towards fellow fiends, teachers and employees of this college.
